- ♦ The timings will be as follows:

❖ For LKG : 8:00 am - 12 noon, **Only for the first week : 8:00 am to 11:00 am.**

❖ For UKG : 8:00 am - 1:00 pm
❖ For I - V : 7:30 am - 1:15 pm
❖ For VI - VIII : 7:20 am - 1:25 pm
❖ For IX - X : 7:20 am - 1:30 pm

- Punctuality is to be observed by all the children.
- Only the students of VI to X are permitted to come to school independently by bicycle.
- No student is allowed to come by Scooter / Motor Cycle.
- ♦ The school authorities will not be responsible for the students who are roaming outside school campus after the school hours, for any reason whatsoever. In case of delay in the conveyance, the students may remain within the school campus. Hence, you are requested to instruct your ward accordingly. (Please arrange the conveyance within 10 minutes of the final bell).
